## Ideas for Telling Time Memory Cards

- Put the analog clock cards face up in a row. Put the digital (time) clock cards face down in a pile. Pick a time card and find the clock that matches it. Keep the matched cards. Then, pick another time card and match again, until there are no cards left.
- Put the cards face down in an array and play a memory game. Each person picks two cards. If they match you keep them, if not you replace them. Play until all cards are matched.
- Pick a time (digital) card. Show that time on a clock face.
- $\quad$ Pick an analog clock face. Write that time in digital form (2:15 or 2:30).


## Ideas for Using Coin Spinners

- Spin and take the coin you spun. After 3 spins, count your coins to find the total money you have.
- Roll a die and spin the coin spinner. If you rolled 4 and spun a dime, you get 4 dimes. How much money did you get?
- Play with a partner: Spin and count then compare the value of your coins to your partner's coins. Who has more money?


## Ideas for Using Money Value Spinners

- Spin to find a money value. Show 2 ways you can make that value with coins.
- Challenge: How can you make the value with the least coins?
- Play with a partner: Each player spins. Who has the most money?
